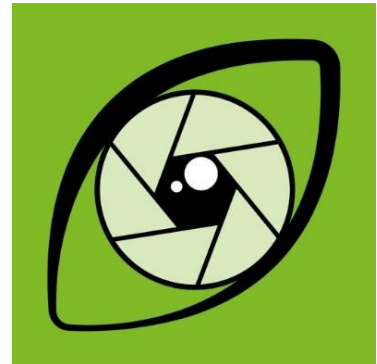


Instant Wild: exploring endangered animals and conservation

ZSL's Instant Wild allows you to take part in vital conservation work, bringing you LIVE images and videos from amazing locations all around the world.

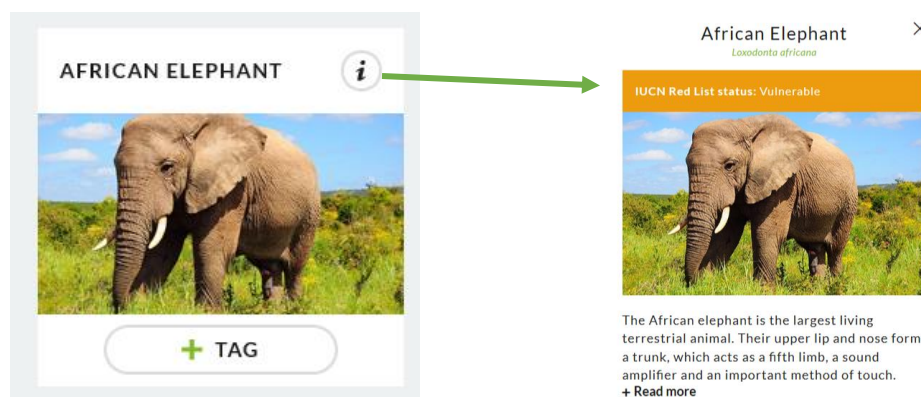
By identifying the animals in each image, you are contributing to conservation and making a positive impact on the future for wildlife.

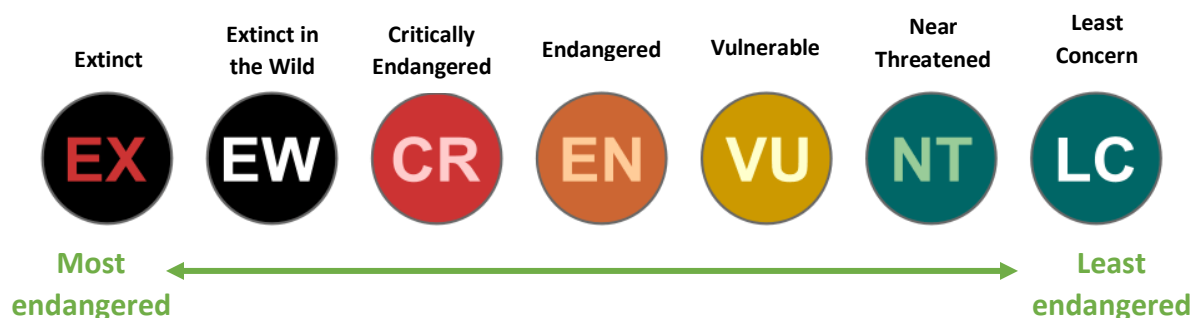


Explore the app and then see if you can answer the following questions using your own research:
