for outstanding work in zoology

The winner of the ZSL Charles Darwin Award and Marsh Prize receives a certificate and a monetary prize of £800

The Award is open to undergraduate students attending university in Great Britain or Northern Ireland for an outstanding zoological project carried out and written by an undergraduate during the period September 2015 to August 2016. Projects will be accepted a month before or a month after these dates.

Heads of Department are requested to recommend one undergraduate research student whose project was considered to be outstanding.

A letter or recommendation, along with the project and a detailed report on the candidate's work, should be sent to:

Recommendations must be received no later than 30 November 2016.

The following additional information should also be submitted:

1. The degree the candidate is studying
2. The length of time over which the project was undertaken.
3. The nature and extent of assistance given to the undergraduate.

The Council of ZSL request that the candidate should not be told of the recommendation.
