The winner of the ZSL Charles Darwin Award and Marsh Prize receives a certificate and a monetary prize of £800.

The Award is open to undergraduate students attending university in Great Britain or Northern Ireland for an outstanding zoological project carried out during the period September 2016 to August 2017. Projects will be accepted a month before or a month after these dates.

Heads of Department are requested to recommend **one** undergraduate research student whose project was considered to be outstanding.

A letter or recommendation, along with the project and a detailed report on the candidate's work, should be sent to:

Recommendations must be received by **30 November 2017**.

The following additional information should also be submitted:

2. The length of time over which the project was undertaken.
3. The nature and extent of assistance given to the undergraduate.
