Safeguarding space for nature, securing our future: developing a post-2020 strategy

We are rapidly losing Earth's wild species and wild spaces, with [global vertebrate populations on track to decline by two-thirds by 2020](#). Under the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)'s Aichi Target 11, governments have pledged to protect 17% land and 10% sea by this date. But are conventional protected areas working, is this target enough, and if not what space do we need to conserve and how in order to sustain humans and the rest of life on earth?

Over the next few years, governments will be reviewing the current CBD 2011-2020 strategic plan and considering a new strategy to meet the Convention's vision of halting the loss of biodiversity and maintaining ecosystem services and a healthy planet for all by 2050, as part of the wider 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

As part of this process, and in support of IUCN Resolution [WCC-2016-Res-096-EN](#), this symposium will bring together scientists, policy-makers and the public to (1) review and agree science-based targets, (2) evaluate various policy options and (3) raise awareness of the need for a more ambitious, holistic and effective post-2020 strategy on space for nature, incorporating protected areas and other effective area-based conservation measures.

This symposium will gather international scientific experts, policy makers and funders to generate greater political awareness of the need for a more ambitious and more effective strategy for safeguarding space for nature


