<p>Community Based Ecological Mangrove Restoration</p>	<p>Thailand</p>	<p>The Mangrove Action Project (MAP) teaches short training courses on Community based Ecological Mangrove Restoration (CBEMR) from 2 to 12 days in length which are custom designed for the workshop participants and region. MAP started to give CBEMR courses in 2005 in the response to the huge failures in mangrove planting which were occurring post tsunami throughout the region. CBEMR places strong emphasis on correcting the hydrology and removing stressors so that mangroves can regenerate naturally with the goal of full ecosystem restoration, with higher biodiversity compared to planting alone and closer species composition to surrounding natural mangrove. Trainings involve both theory, and field study exercises. Hands-on field work at a demonstration site can be added, if desired by the host, putting the theory into practice.</p>
