## Sparkling Wine

**Prosecco Spumante, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy** £36.00

This wonderfully pretty Prosecco is so beautifully balanced and fresh, with flavours of ripe apple and a very subtle grapiness leading to a really crystal clean finish.

**Harrow & Hope Brut Reserve NV, England (Vegan)** £45.00

A blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meniere, Harrow & Hope's gold medal winning brut reserve wine is made in the same style as traditional Champagne. Producing a bright and lively sparkling wine with crisp green apple, lemon, brioche flavours and a refreshing finish.

## White Wine

**Solano Blanco, Galicia, Spain, 2017** £24.00, £6.00 (125 ml)  
Very easy drinking and full of flavour, this has an attractive balance and a clean crisp finish.

**Goleta Sauvignon Blanc, Chile, 2017** £30.00  
A classical Sauvignon Blanc with bright aromas of citrus fruits and herbaceous notes of capsicum. A refreshing wine with crisp acidity that will have you coming back for more.

**War Horse Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2017** £32.00

This Chenin Blanc is full of ripe apple and pear flavours as well as hints of tropical fruit that are rounded out by a crisp, refreshing finish. This is a very versatile white from leading South African producer Simonsig that can be enjoyed on its own or alongside a variety of lighter dishes such as fish and salad.

## Rose Wine

**La Loupe, Carignan Rosé 2017, Languedoc, France** £30.00

Crisp and clean with a good citric acidity and flavours of strawberry, raspberry, and red cherry with subtle floral hints of rose and blossom. A perfect summer wine, easy-drinking and very fresh.

## Red Wine

**Solanto Tinto, Galicia, Spain, 2017** £24.00, £6.00 (125 ml)  
A blend of peppery Garnacha and rich Tempranillo with a sizeable dollop of Cabernet Sauvignon to add backbone.

**Goleta Merlot, Central Valley, Chile, 2017** £30.00  
Goleta's Merlot is a beautifully easy drinking, fruity red with juicy plums, succulent black currants, and soft tannins.

**Valcheta Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016** £37.00  
Winemaker Jon Usabiaga has made a textbook Malbec from Mendoza with youthful, ripe blackcurrant aromas and slight hints of dark chocolate. It is a deliciously balanced wine with a pleasing spicy finish
